I. Preemergent Weed Control in Ornamental Beds:

A. Broadleaf weed controls

isoxaben + trifluralin	Snapshot TG

B. Grassy weed controls

pronamide	Kerb

C. Nutsedge control

II. Postemergent Weed Control in Ornamental Beds:

A. Selective grassy weed controls

clethodium	Envoy
diquat	Reward ²
fluazifop-p-butyl	Fusilade II, Ornamec
fenoxaprop	Acclaim
pelarogonic acid	Scythe ²

2. do not allow product to contact desirable vegetation

B. Non-selective grassy weed controls

C. Nutsedge controls

D.Broadleaf weed controls

Common name	Trade name(s)
clopyralid	Lontrel

Note: always read the label carefully before purchasing and before applying to make sure which weeds can be controlled and to determine which ornamental plants the products can be safely applied around. Also, the labels can be changed over time and may no longer be labeled for use in ornamental beds.

The above list is not a complete list of herbicides available for use in ornamental beds, but does contain the more commonly found products used for ornamental bed weed control.
